

Here is how you may inquire about Ghana Investment Club (GIC):

1. Log onto <http://www.gicghana.com>
2. Click on **How to become a GIC Partner**
3. Click on Constitution, print and READ. Also read GIC Financial Report and FAQ
4. When you are convinced that GIC is a good investment vehicle for you:
 - a. Print and complete Application Form.
 - b. If you have access to a scanner, use **Uploading partner signature information** to upload scanned image to GIC website. Otherwise, please fax your completed form to GIC's eFax number at (313)-557-0630
5. Send an email to the GIC Executives (<http://www.gicghana.com>) to be advised which of the two GSE brokerage companies (Databank or SDC) to wire your money.
6. If directed to remit funds to Databank, please print **Databank Brokerage Fund Transfer – All Countries**. Otherwise, please print **SDC Brokerage Fund Transfer – All Countries**
7. Remit your investment funds (US\$1,000 minimum up to US\$20,000) via directions detailed in #6
8. Let GIC Executives (**List of GIC Officers**) know via email about your remittance to Databank Brokerage or SDC Brokerage. Upon receipt of your email, the GIC Treasurer will check with the respective broker representative if the remittance (a requirement for your GIC partnership) can be confirmed
